READING/ELA

We cover a new story from our *Journeys* Reading book each week. Throughout the week, we cover new story vocabulary, the comprehension skill, fluency practice, additional vocabulary skills, etc. These skills will be checked with a weekly test on Friday, which will probably be done through Google Classroom.

A.R. Points: Your child will be expected to read at least 4 chapter books each trimester and complete a book report with each one.

MATH

We will still be using our IReady curriculum.

Work will be done in class. The only homework for math will be practicing their multiplication cards.



SCIENCE/SOCIAL STUDIES

We have a new Science series this year that we will be experimenting with.

S.S. is also newer this year. It's a program called TCI and it's also online. We will use it along with paper handouts. **Spelling:** Typically, we cover a new Spelling list each week. The words can be found in the *Journeys* Practice Book or on the paper copy of the list I send home with them each Monday. Students will have an activity to do as homework each night to make sure they're practicing.

*Tests are on Friday



Handwriting: We have a D'Nealian workbook to practice proper formation of cursive letters and transitions from one letter to another.

Writing: In 4th grade we work on writing narrative, expository, and persuasive pieces of writing throughout the year.




